

## FARMER/PRODUCER EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT GUIDELINES

The Kentucky State University Center for the Sustainability of Farms and Families (KSU-CSFF) offers an educational support program to support small-scale farmers/producers in the expansion of certain types of agriculture in Kentucky, especially among certain underserved groups. Grant funding decisions are based upon the impact expected on the production and sales of Kentucky-grown or Kentucky-raised farm products.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR AN EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT GRANT?

- Farmers or producers interested in specific training to improve the marketability of their agricultural products.
- Farmers or producers interested in new ventures that require training for on-site implementation.
- Special considerations will be made for:
  - limited-resource farmers (annual household income of less than \$23,000)
  - small acreage producers
  - female farmers
  - minority farmers
  - residents of USDA-designated food-insecure counties (see map on page 10)

- Grantees must comply with all health, food safety, and other federal, state, and local laws.

- Kentucky State University employees and their immediate family members are not eligible.

#### THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Applications must be received at least 30-90 days in advance of the conference/workshop date.
- Incomplete applications will not be rolled over to another award cycle to await information. The applicant must complete the application and resubmit for consideration in another funding cycle.
- Conference, training, or workshop agenda and/or information must be included with the application.
- Requests for educational books must be supported with an online quote or shopping cart list.
- Approvals are dependent on the availability of funds. If more applicants qualify than there are funds available, awards will be made with applications scoring the highest, continuing down the list until all funds are expended.
- Funds approved must be used solely for the benefit of the agricultural business, which must be located in Kentucky.
- Out-of-state educational trainings may qualify but must be pre-approved. Priority is given to in-state trainings.
- Recipients will be required to provide a detailed report and verification of all expenditures.
- Workshops or trainings attended prior to the execution of the contract will not be eligible for grant funds.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### WHAT ARE MY OBLIGATIONS FOR ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS?

You will sign a legal contract that obligates you to use the funds as stated in your application budget, provide data related to your project, and submit reports outlining the impact of the project. The terms and conditions are specific to your project. Failure to fulfill reporting requirements, including submittal of receipts, will be considered a breach of contract and funds must be forfeited.

#### WHAT CAN I USE THE MONEY FOR?

- Funding for educational support must be pre-approved (prior to attending any workshop, conference, etc. OR the purchase of educational literature) and can be used for registration fees, specific travel (flight, bus, train) and, in some cases, mileage on personal vehicles (reimbursed at \$0.41/mile).
- · Meals and fuel costs are excluded from funding.
- Examples of funding may include but are not limited to:
  - Better Processing Control School offered by the University of Kentucky
  - Aquaculture and/or aquaponics training
  - Appropriate educational books, literature, and/or online webinars
  - Conferences

#### WHAT IS THE APPROVAL PROCESS AND TIMELINE?

The Grant Review Committee considers all applications received by the stated deadlines and votes to recommend funding, deny funding or pend for further clarification.

- "Recommended" applicant data is submitted to the Kentucky Office of Agricultural Policy (KOAP) for final approval.
- "Recommended" and "Pended" applicants may be subject to a site visit to verify capacity to administer the grant.
- "Approved" applicants are notified via email and must submit further legal documentation provided by Kentucky State.
- Final authorization and Kentucky State administrative signatures must be obtained prior to the disbursement of approved funding.
- Upon final authorization, approved grant funds will be disbursed via Direct Deposit.

Please note: You are required to submit proof of registration and attendance to the conference or training with a report/summary of your experience and receipts.
