1. Download the Duo Mobile App



2. Log in to your email.

Go to www.kysu.edu. Scroll down to the green search bar and click on email.



Enter your username and password. Follow prompts on phone screen and phone for setting up the Duo Mobile App for authentication.

3. Log in to Canvas

Return to www.kysu.edu. On the same green bar, click on the canvas icon. If you are logged into your email, it should log you directly into Canvas. If not, utilize username and password listed above.

Have a 504 or IEP?

If you have a 504 Plan and require accommodations for your dual credit course, here is the process to have your plan submitted to Kentucky State's Office of Dual Credit:

- This first step will depend on the process at your high school. Either you or your high school will submit your 504 Plan to Ally Barfield-McClure (<u>Dorothy.barfield@kysu.edu</u>) and Katy Doyle (<u>elizabeth.doyle1@kysu.edu</u>). Please ask your counselor for guidance on how to initiate this process.
- Then the Office of Dual Credit will coordinate with the campus' Office of Disability Services and your professor(s) to ensure that your accommodations are met.
- Important Notes:
 - You must resubmit your request for accommodation (and 504 Plan) at the beginning of every semester.
 - You must also submit an updated 504 Plan if any changes are made during the semester.
