Admission Requirements

- Admission to Kentucky State University
- An earned Associates Degree in Nursing from KCTCS Nursing program.
- Official transcripts from all schools attended.
- Prerequisite education courses completed and on the official transcript before beginning the Nursing program at Kentucky State University.
- Overall GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale on associate degree coursework.
- Verification of current unencumbered license to practice nursing in the prospective student's state of residence prior to enrollment in first program course.
- Personal essay.
- One academic and one professional reference
- Apply to Nursing School

Degree Requirements

- An earned Associates Degree in Nursing from a nationally accredited nursing program.
