POLICY STATEMENT:

Kentucky State University is committed to providing students adequate due process whenever they are alleged to have committed an alcohol-, drug-, or tobacco-related violation. The University will therefore always adhere to the procedures found in the Behavioral Code of Conduct and KRS 164.370 when investigating and adjudicating an alleged violation.

University Housing, however, is a privilege, not a right. Thus, if the All-University Court determines that a student has violated the University's policies on alcohol, drugs, or tobacco while residing in a University-owned residential facility, the University reserves the right to evict the student from University Housing for the remainder of the current semester.
